Dear RNC Members,

We are excited to announce that the Committee on Arrangements for the 2020 Republican National Convention (COA) is now accepting nominations for the page program at the 2020 Republican National Convention in Charlotte, North Carolina. The goal of the program is to create opportunities for young adults to have a positive, educational experience as part of the convention, as well as developing the next generation of Republicans.

You may begin submitting nominations for the page program using the attached form, which must be signed by at least two (2) RNC Members from your respective state, territory, district, or island. Each state, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, American Samoa, Guam, the Northern Mariana Islands, and the U.S. Virgin Islands will be appointed at least two (2) pages each. The deadline for nominations is May 15, 2020.

Page duties will involve vital convention-related activities such as acting as floor runners, assisting with caucus meetings, and distributing official convention materials. In addition, there may be several other activities planned and duties may differ each day. Activities may also include educational programs, speakers and community service. Please be aware that pages are not assured convention floor credentials. The tasks they are assigned to perform at the convention will determine their access during any given session.

Pages must be 16 to 22 years old, or enrolled in college, at the time of the convention. Pages must arrive prior to the start of the convention on Saturday, August 22, 2020 and remain in Charlotte until the morning of Friday, August 28, 2020. They are required to attend an orientation and all scheduled events. Those who do not report for scheduled activities or fail to abide by the rules and deadlines of the page program may be dismissed from the page program.

Pages will be responsible for arranging and paying for their own transportation to and from Charlotte, meals other than those provided, and any incidentals. Pages will be assigned a roommate and will be housed at a nearby hotel or dorm. The COA will provide transportation to and from the assigned hotel/dorm and official functions. Enclosed you will also find a FAQ document which can be shared with potential candidates.

Again, please submit your nomination form by May 15, 2020. Once the form is completed and signed, please return to Jennifer Oringdulph, at pageprogram@2020gopconvention.com. If you have any questions, you may contact her by calling (704) 492-4308. Acceptance into the page program will be confirmed based on approval by the RNC Chairman, the COA Chairman, and the COA President and CEO. Upon acceptance by the COA, selected nominees will receive an information packet from our office with all the pertinent details about their participation in the page program.

Thank you for your continued support of the convention and vital efforts such as the page program. We look forward to seeing you in Charlotte!
